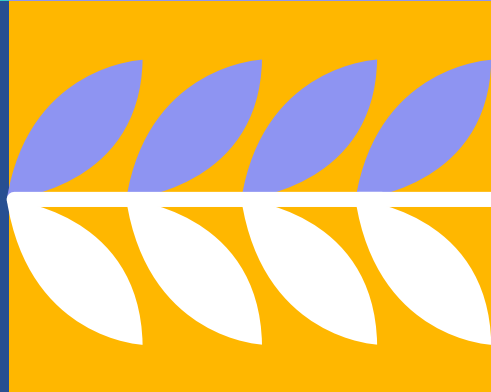
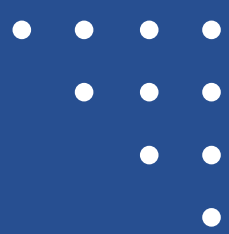

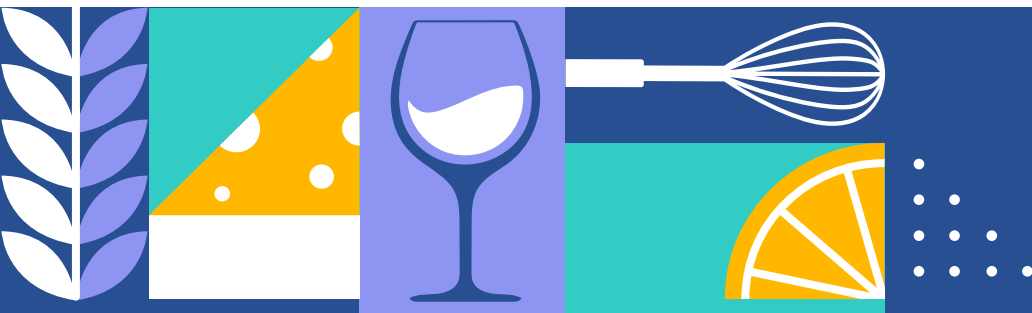
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## GENEROSITY

# TASTING STATION HOST

## BENEFITS AND GUIDELINES

*Hosting a Tasting Station at the American Cancer Society's Taste of Hope is a unique opportunity for a restaurant or food provider to make a commitment to the health and wellbeing of our community.*

### RECOGNITION BENEFITS

- Names and/or logos of all tasting station hosts will be included on the Taste of Hope website and social media.
- Tasting Station Host names will be listed in pre-event publicity materials.
- Promotion on the screens at the event
- Logo included in pre-event media coverage. (2021 coverage included NBC Chicago Today feature, Chicago Sun Times, social media )

### EXPECTATIONS

Tasting station hosts will provide:

- Tasting-size samples of a signature dish or cocktail, with enough samples for a crowd of 1,000 guests. (Note: Hosts are responsible for all costs related to their food/drink item(s)).
- Equipment necessary to prepare and/or heat their samples, display materials, and decorations for their table. (Note: There will be limited power available to restaurant participants, if food needs to be kept warm please bring butane burners.)
- Staff member(s) to staff the station and serve guests at the event.
- Slip-mat or preferred safety floor covering for spillage (space is carpeted)
- Tasting station hosts must sign an indemnification agreement and submit proof of insurance listing the American Cancer Society as additionally insured by 9.1.22.

### THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY WILL PROVIDE FOR EACH STATION

- 8 ft serving table
- Disposable serve ware (napkins, plates, bowls, tasting cups, and silverware).
- Tabletop signage.

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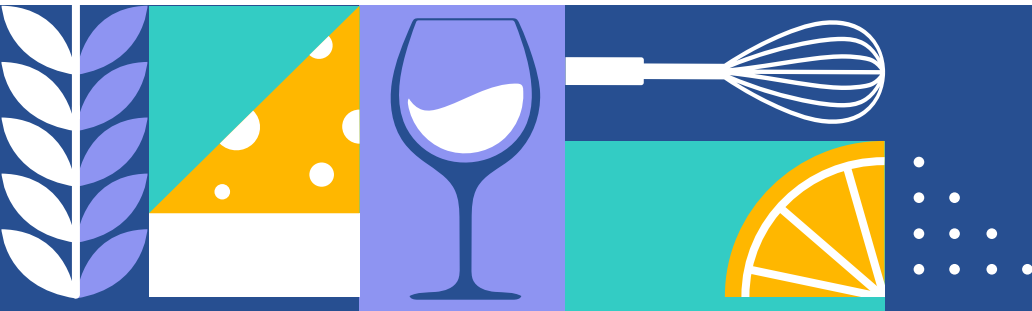
